Consequently, teachers in all areas will be helping their students see the spiritual dimension of their subject and the practical consequences of moral principles and faith.
- The goal is to prepare the student to progress to the next higher-level of educational endeavour. Included in this is the development of higher level thinking skills, awareness of occupational opportunities, and awareness of God's hand in His creation.

ADMISSIONS POLICY
